
#### **About Multan:**

Multan is Located on the banks of the Chenab River, it is Pakistan's seventh most populous city and is the major cultural and economic center of Southern Punjab.

Multan's history stretches deep into antiquity. The ancient city was site of the renowned Multan Sun Temple, and was besieged by Alexander the Great during the Mallian Campaign. Multan was one of the most important trading canters of medieval Islamic India, and attracted a multitude of Sufi mystics in the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> centuries, earning the city the nickname City of Saints. The city, along with the nearby city of Uch, is renowned for its large collection of Sufi shrines dating from that era.







**Connectivity:** Multan International Airport is located 10 km west of Multan's city center, in the Multan Cantonment. The airport offers flights throughout Pakistan, as well as to the Persian Gulf States. Multan is connected by railway track with all parts of the country and lies on the main track between Karachi, Peshawar, Lahore and Quetta. Multan is also connected with all cities of the country by bus via GT road and motorways.
